

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 and 64 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, Carrington Winery Jade LP is authorized to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 104 Matai Bay Road, Karikari Peninsula 0483, Far North District and known as "Karikari Estate", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day. However, a person may sell or deliver grape wine or fruit wine on Easter Sunday if the grape wine or fruit wine is made -
 - (i) on the premises: or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- Alcohol may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours: (b)

Monday to Sunday 10.00 am to 10.00 pm

- Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as a supervised area: Any bar and wine sales (c)
- (d) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorized in of from the premises generally. The premises, situated at 104 Matai Bay Road, Karikari Peninsula 0483, Far North District, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Far North District Licensing Committee on 12th February 2014.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
 - Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-(b)
 - Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
